Important Contest Information:

1. Teams will only be permitted to occupy and set-up their assigned space after 5:00 pm Thursday, October 18, 2018 or after 9:00 a.m. Friday, October 19, 2018 unless this date and time is changed by Contest Director.
2. All teams must comply with City of Nelsonville Fire Safety Code regarding the following items:
 - a. Each team must have an approved (Type A or Type ABC) fire extinguisher available on the cooking site.
 - b. Any team having an LP fuel tank, in use or in storage, must secure the tank in a bracket designed for the tank or have it secured with a steel chain and metallic fasteners. No materials other than chain are permissible.
3. All teams must be contained completely within the specified space as assigned. No vehicles or tents will be allowed outside the specified dimensions into the fire lane or sidewalk. Public parking is available around the contest area and the Rocky Brands parking lot adjacent to the train depot.
4. Teams will be assigned a space by Festival staff. Requests for specific spaces will be accommodated as much as possible but specific spaces will not be guaranteed. If you have a specific desired space or location, please make note on page 1 of the application.
5. Electric connection, if applicable, and water connection are provided on contest grounds. Each team is responsible for providing proper and adequate cables, cords, hoses, and adapters to ensure a safe and proper connection to the provided utilities. These connections may be up to 125 feet from any competitor's space.
 - a. Provided electric service is **110V/20A ONLY**. No other electric service is provided or available.
6. Any team wishing to provide any vending service must have current vending license and will be subject to a separate inspection by local health department officials. Vending regulations are set by the Athens City-County Health Department, not the Contest Director or staff.
